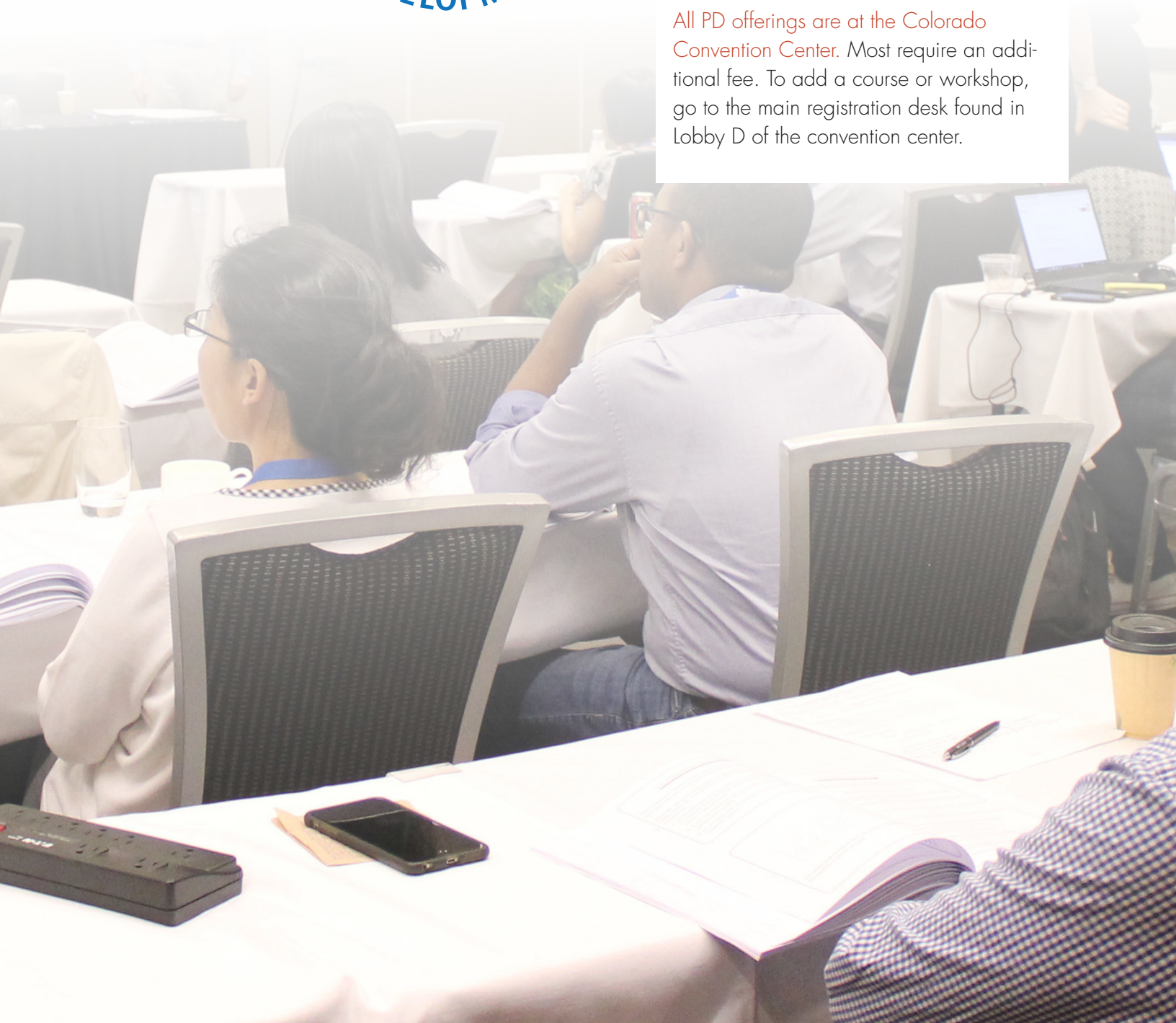


# Professional Development
